Dress Code

- T-shirts No T-shirts allowed except at the Pool and Turn Shack.
 - Appropriate attire for men in the quiet dining room, banquet room, or Bar for casual visits includes slacks, Bermuda style shorts, dress blue jeans, buttoned shirts, golf shirts and closed-toe shoes or nice sandals. No flip flops are permitted.
 - Appropriate attire in the Quiet Dining Room,
 Banquet Room, or Bar for women for casual visits
 include dresses, skirts, capri or cropped pants,
 Bermuda style shorts, dress blue jeans, blouses or
 tops with appropriate coverage, golf and racquet
 attire are permitted but must also include
 appropriate coverage and limited to Bar only. No
 flip flops are permitted.
